# WEDNESDAY

You have arrived in Newport, a town where lighthouses, fishing boats, and local art all meet at the edge of the Pacific. Check into a harbor-view inn, a beachfront rental, or one of Newport's cozy historic motels. Find lodging options on page 44.

## **AFTERNOON**

Stretch your legs with a stroll along the historic Bayfront. Stop by

Chelsea Rose Fresh Seafood to see the daily catch, then head to Port

Dock One to watch the sea lions bark, nap, and entertain for hours.

#### **EVENING**

Dine like a local at:

- Clearwater Restaurant: Order the Dungeness crab mac & cheese.
- Local Ocean Seafoods: Grab a table upstairs for a harbor view as fishing boats unload the day's catch. Pro tip: make a reservation.





# **THURSDAY**

## **MORNING**

Start your day at Yaquina Head
Outstanding Natural Area. Arrive
early to beat the crowds and check
the tide chart (see page 32). The
tidepools are especially vibrant at
low tide.

## **AFTERNOON**

- Visit the Oregon Coast
   Aquarium, one of the top aquariums in the nation, where you can walk through a shark tunnel, meet tufted puffins, and see playful sea otters up close.
- Visit Oregon Coast Glassworks, where you can blow your own glass float, a modern take on Newport's fishing float history.

#### **EVENING**

- End the day with a bonfire and s'mores at Nye Beach.
- Catch a stunning sunset at the Yaquina Bay Lighthouse.

# **FRIDAY**

### **MORNING**

- Cozy up at Café Stephanie in Nye Beach with a homemade cinnamon roll or scone. Misty mornings, hot coffee, and warm pastries, need we say more?
- If fresh fruit and acai bowls are more your style, Ultralife
   Café is your new go-to. Take your smoothie or bowl and wander through Nye Beach's boutique shops.

# **AFTERNOON**

Let's get you out on the water.

- Paddle alongside seals and sea lions with a guided kayak tour of the bay from the Oregon
   Boating Foundation. Tours last two hours and take you through Newport's working waterfront.
- Join Marine Discovery Tours for a whale-watching excursion. From gray whales to plankton, these popular tours showcase the coast from a whole new perspective.

#### **EVENING**

Enjoy a live performance at the **Newport Performing Arts Center**. From opera and plays to jazz concerts, the PAC is buzzing with talent year-round.

- Take a short drive to Seal Rock for dramatic tidepools, striking basalt formations, and fewer crowds.
- Visit Pirates Plunder in the Aquarium Village where a treasure is to be fund at every price point.

Choose your vibe:

- **Upscale: Zurita** with creative tapas and locally sourced ingredients.
- Casual: Nana's Irish Pub with hearty food, pints, and live music.
- Bar: Rogue's Sunset Bar with craft beers, spirits, and a front-row view of the harbor.

- Sleep in, then browse Nye
  Beach Book House, a cozy used
  bookstore with beachtown charm
  or see what local exhibitions are at
  the Newport Visual Arts Center.
- Grab a breakfast burrito from Nye Beach Café before heading out.

- Pick up smoked salmon or crab togo from South Beach Fish Market.
